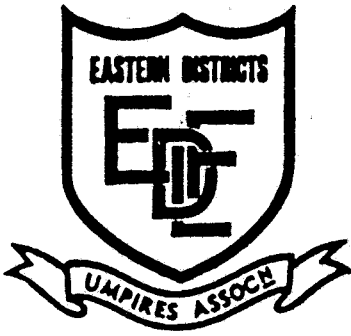




TREASURER'S REPORT
