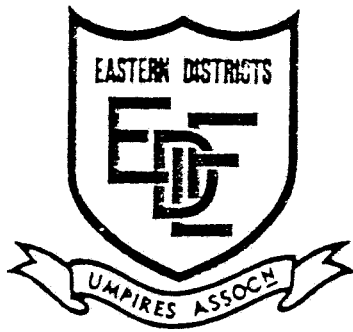
To National Mutual our 87 Sponsor, we thank you and hope we have given good value for money. The assistance you have given this Association has been appreciated.

These ground rules are:

Umpiring U/10 and U/12 games in one day is one appointment only.

One U/10 or U/12 game only - one appointment.

Games umpired in Waverley Junior F.L. not counted.

Practice matches not counted.

Interleague, Exchange and all other E.D.F.L. appointed games - one appointment.

I hope that this clarifies the situation, particularly in relation to U/10 and U/12 games.

I welcome any queries from Umpires on their statistics and in particular any information on those Umpires who officiated prior to 1979 and whose statistics haven't been upgraded.
