It has been a really enjoyable experience for me to serve as your president for season 1988, and I believe it to have been a most successful year as far the Association was concerned.

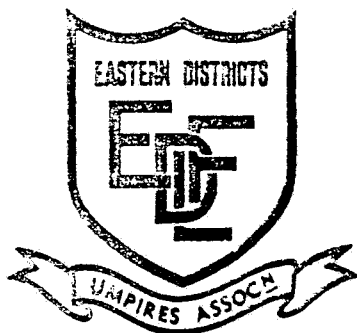
