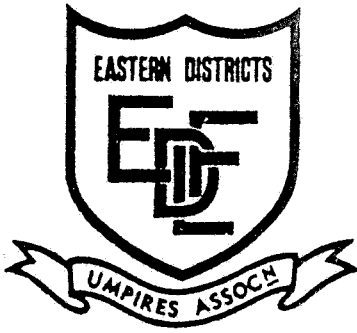
I hope that our members will give us the support the Association will need to get the Clubrooms up and running. There is a lot to be done to make this venture successful with your help we can do it.



NOTE 1: ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- (a) Basis
The accounting policies adopted by the Association follow the historical cost principles of the accounting standards issued by the Australian accounting bodies. These policies have been consistently applied.
- (b) Stocks
Stocks have been valued at cost. Cost is based on the first in first out basis.

NOTE 2: INCOME TAX

The Association is exempt from income tax as the majority of its income is mutually exclusive under current income tax legislation.

NOTE 3: CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

At balance date the Association had not entered into any contracts for capital works.
