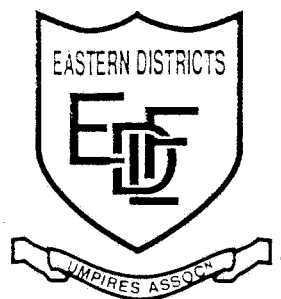

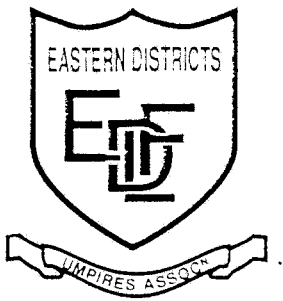

David Biggs (Treasurer), - There is never any worry or doubt concerning "The balancing of the books". A very professional operator.

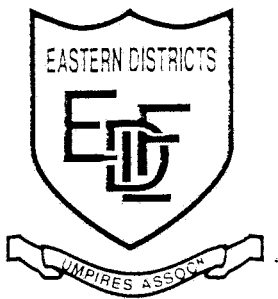
Trevor Fyander (Social Secretary), - A real contributor for many years with this year being no exception. Always ready to complete any job any time.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER, 1992

NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with Statements of Accounting Concepts and applicable Accounting Standards. The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or except where stated current valuations of non-current assets. These accounting policies have been consistently applied.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Association in the preparation of the accounts.

(a) Inventories

Inventories have been valued at cost on the first in first out basis.

(b) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from income tax as the majority of its income is mutually exclusive under current income tax legislation.

(c) Plant and Equipment

Plant and Equipment are brought to account at cost less any accumulated depreciation or amortisation.

The depreciable amount of all fixed assets are depreciated over their useful lives. Leasehold improvements are amortised over the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.

NOTE 2: CROYDON PARK - LEASEHOLD IMPROVEMENTS

The Association has entered into a lease contract with the City of Croydon through the Springfield Sporting Development Group Incorporated (SSDG) to lease the rooms at Croydon Park for fifteen (15) years from 23rd December, 1991. The SSDG is a joint venture with the Croydon Rangers Gridiron Club.

The Association pays a levy based on the number of members it has registered (presently \$20 per member) to the SSDG from which the SSDG finances its operations.

NOTE 3: LOAN - CROYDON RANGERS GRIDIRON CLUB

The Association has lent \$25,000 to the Croydon Rangers Gridiron Club as its share of the leasehold improvements to the pavilion at Croydon Park. The loan is repayable by at least \$2,000 per annum until such time as the sum of \$25,000 has been repaid.

NOTE 4: CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

At balance date the Association had not entered into any contract for capital works not otherwise reported in these accounts.
