I thank the umpires for putting up with me, my demands, voice and bloody mindedness and look forward to us all having an enjoyable 1996 in umpiring.

Scope

We have audited the financial statements of EASTERN DISTRICTS FOOTBALL LEAGUE UMPIRES' ASSOCIATION INC., for the year ended 31st December 1995. The Committee is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information they contain. NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER 1995

NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with Statements of Accounting Concepts and applicable Accounting Standards. The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. These account policies have been consistently applied.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Association in the preparation of these accounts.

(a) Inventories

Inventories have been valued by the Committee, which is on the same basis as previous years.

(b) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from income tax as the majority of its income is mutually exclusive under current income tax legislation.

Plant and Equipment

Plant and Equipment is brought to account at cost less any accumulated depreciation or amortisation.

The depreciable amount of all fixed assets are depreciated over their useful life. Leasehold improvements are amortised over the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated life of such improvements.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER 1995

NOTE 2: LEASEHOLD IMPROVEMENTS - CROYDON PARK

This Association has entered into a joint venture with the Croydon Rangers Gridiron Club. This joint venture is titled Springfield Sporting Development Group Incorporated (SSDG). The SSDG entered into a 15 year lease contract, with the City of Croydon now the City of Maroondah to lease the premises at Croydon Park, commencing 23rd December 1991.

NOTE 3: LOAN - CROYDON RANGERS GRIDIRON CLUB

This Association has loaned \$25,000 to the Croydon Rangers Gridiron Club which has been used as its share of the leasehold improvements to the pavilion at Croydon Park. Such loan is repayable by a minimum of \$2000 per annum until such time as the total of \$25,000 has been repaid.

During this financial year \$3,000 has been repaid leaving a balance of \$17,000 still to be repaid.

NOTE 4: CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

At balance date the Association had not entered into any contracts for capital works not otherwise reported in these accounts.
