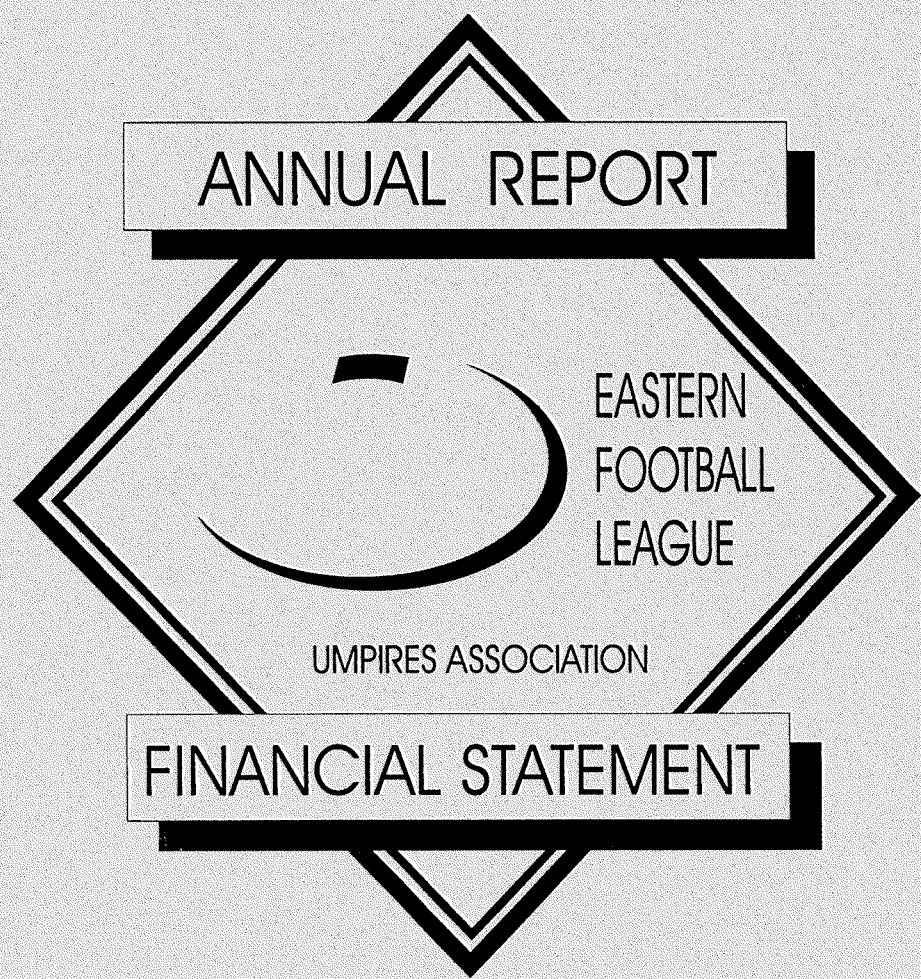

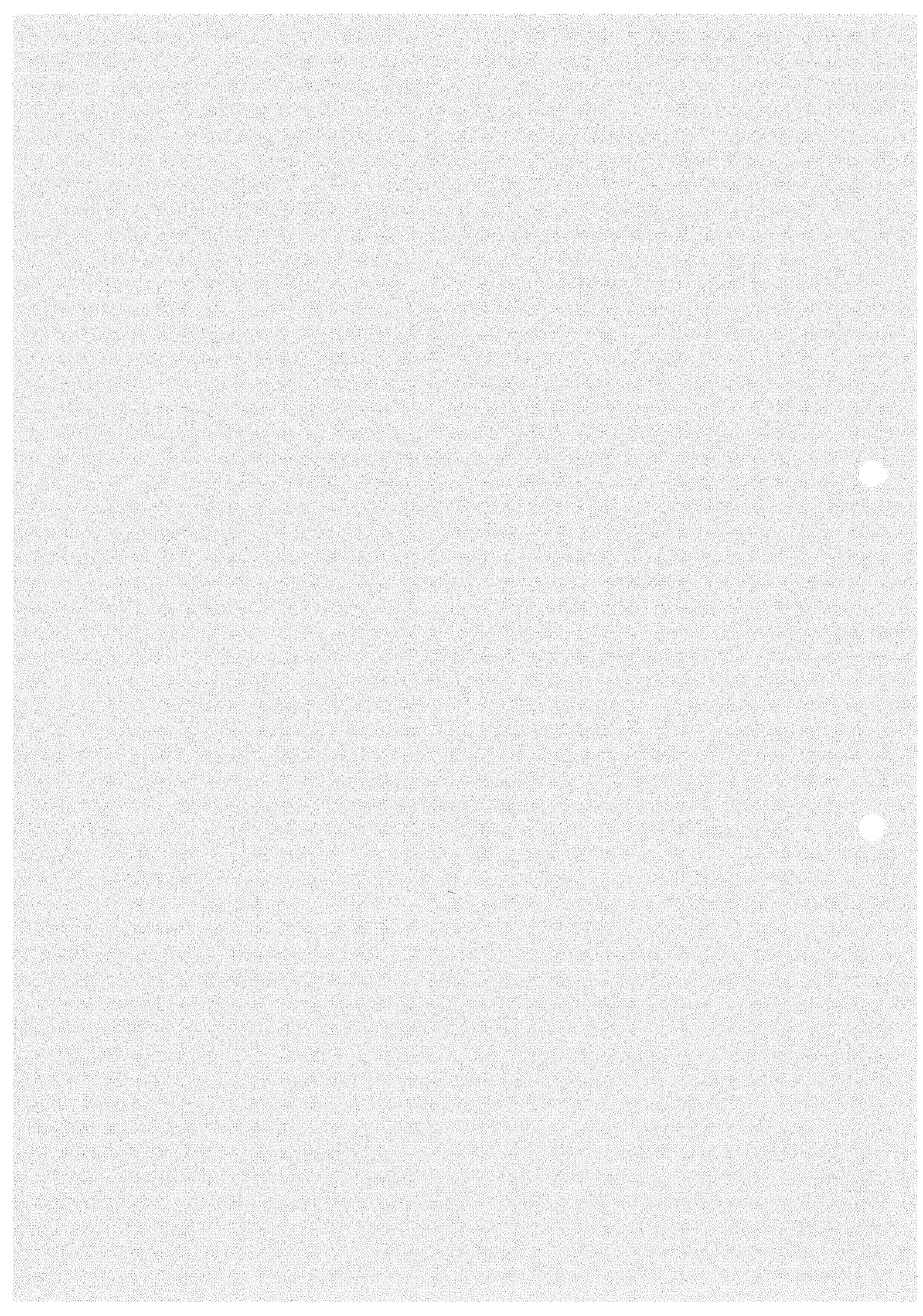

Note 1. Statement of Accounting Policies

These financial statements are special purpose financial reports prepared for use by the members of the Eastern Football League Umpires Association. It has been determined that the association is not a reporting entity

The statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the following applicable accounting standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements

No other applicable Accounting Standards or other mandatory professional reporting requirements have been applied.

The statements are also prepared on an accrual basis. They are based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of these statements:

Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are included at cost, independent or directors' valuation. All assets, excluding freehold land and buildings, are depreciated over their useful lives to the Company.

Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Costs are assigned on a first-in first-out basis and include direct materials, direct labour and an appropriate proportion of variable and fixed overhead expenses.

Scope

In respect of your loan to Croydon Rangers Gridiron Club I cannot find any documentation supporting that the loan exists and therefore cannot comment on the security of the debt.

In respect of the Debtors I cannot locate any documentation to support this amount and therefore have Written-Off the amount as unrecoverable.
