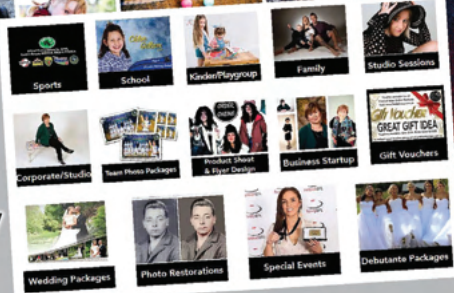

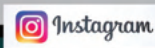

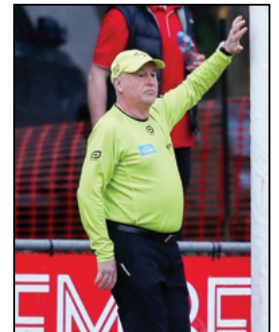

# TREASURERS REPORT

Our bank balance at the end of 2023 was \$3,376.44.

For \$45, the 2023 memberships included an EFLUA beach towel, cards entitling us to 2 free drinks and meal at our social club as well as member only sponsor deals, member draws and subsidies for social events. 2023 will be the final year where memberships cost \$45 for all members.

To align with our rising council costs for use of the pavilion, Fred Geale oval, gridiron field and athletics track, the EFNL contributed \$9,500, compared to \$6,500 in 2022. This left the EFLUA only \$772 out-of-pocket compared to \$2,802 in 2022. We are currently expecting a similar contribution in 2024 from the EFNL.

The biggest expenses and revenues in 2023 were events to cover our much loved social activities such as our barefoot bowls night, trivia night, golf day, mate's round and our largest - The Last Bounce. To advertise this fantastic night, we took a new approach via the use of a text message service to remind members to purchase their tickets during the weeks leading up to the event.

Professional cleaning was sought due to the requirement from council to keep the pavilion up to a standard of cleanliness, resulting in \$4,510 in cleaning expenses. To save on cleaning expenses, the committee will be requesting assistance from umpires with the cleaning of the pavilion on Wednesday nights going forward.

During the year, the EFLUA had 491 members. Due to a previous administration issue, we were only able to retrieve fees from 208 members. The EFLUA are taking relevant steps to ensure this does not happen again, as members will purchase their membership online via the EFLUA website 2024. This will then be deposited into our bank account to eliminate the extra administration incurred when fees were deducted from match payments by the EFNL.

Bar sales were yet again a big success, resulting in a \$3,232 profit and 51.47% profit margin. Kitchen generated a \$426 profit and a 4% profit margin, an increase from -6.12% in 2022.

It was another fantastic year of fundraising, as \$4,113 was raised from raffles, \$1,773 from the pie drive and \$112 from the Good for Footy raffle. \$500 cash was also received from one of our sponsors, The Sporting Globe Knox.

Square has yet again been a convenient platform to purchase our goods given the less cash being used as well as minimising financial risk to the association. In 2023, even less cash was used as EFTPOS sales exceeded cash covering 87.5% of total sales, an increase from 75.8% in 2022. Due to Square's 2.2% fee on transactions, \$440 was spent on Square fees this year, an increase from \$368 due to more EFTPOS sales.

During the year, we introduced a new line of training apparel which featured shorts, shirts, singlets, sweaters and jackets. From a financial perspective, there was almost a break even result from the buying and selling of this apparel.

It was a great second year as Treasurer, and I look forward to continuing my role in 2024.
